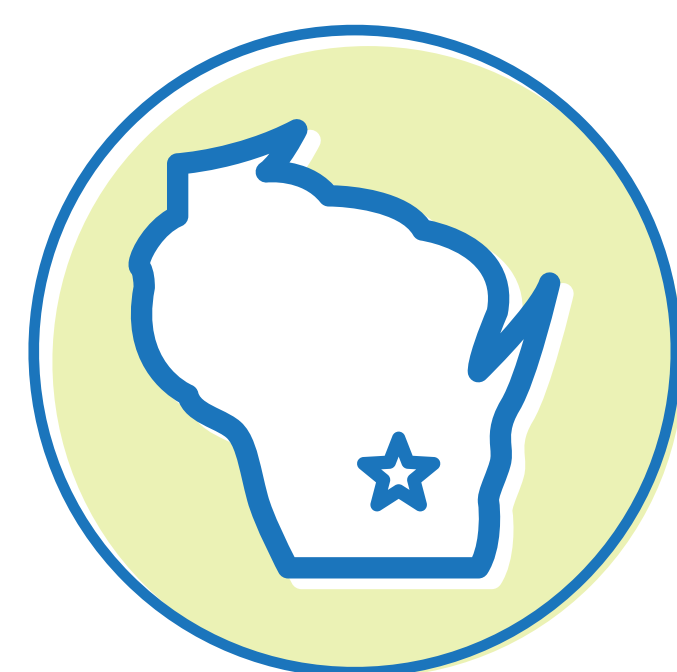
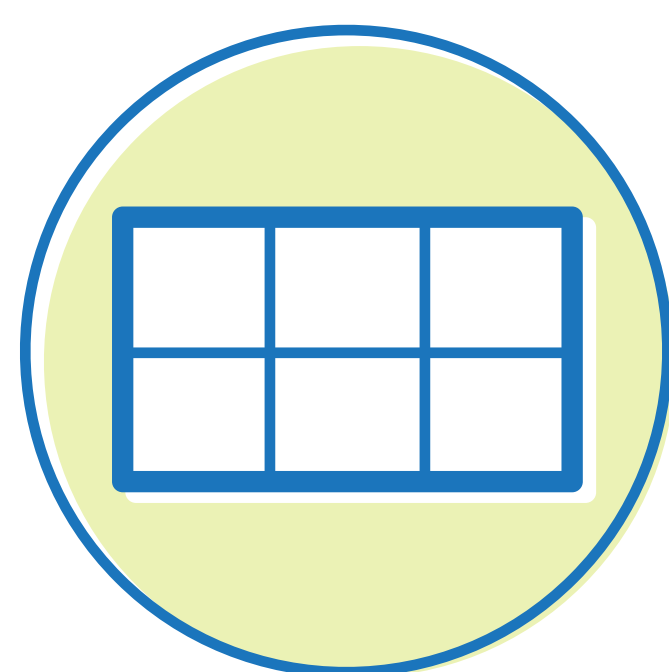
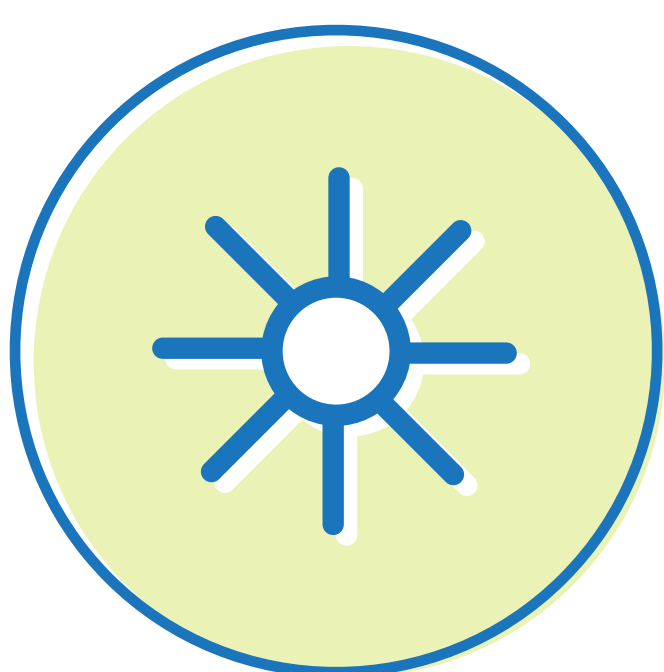
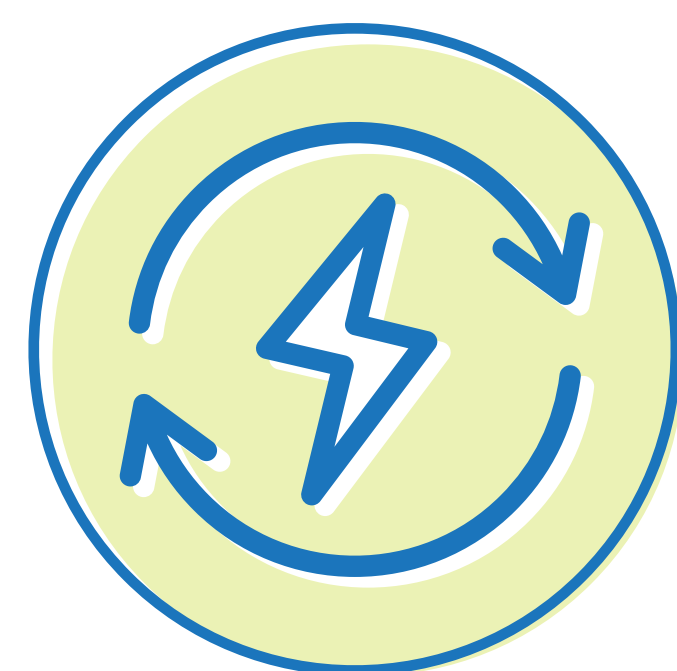




# LANGDON MILLS SOLAR

## About the Project

- Will generate enough clean energy to power 30,000\* homes.
- Expected to be operational in 2024.
- Proposed on approx. 2,000\* acres of privately-owned land.
- Panel height, design, and screening will limit project visibility to neighbors and nearby roads.
- Langdon Mills Solar will maintain and protect the leased land during the life of the project, after which it will revert to the owner's control after full decommissioning of the site.
- Over \$224\* million reinvested back into state and local communities.
- Project helps meet the growing demand for clean, renewable energy sources in Wisconsin.
- Located in Columbia County, WI, south of the Village of Cambria.
